Science	Year 7: 20 questions which the pupils are given at the start of each topic. Year 8: the homework will be a mixture of questions in some topics and specific teacher direction in others.	A combination of exam questions; Seneca and bespoke exam technique strategies by each teacher in their subject.
MFL	Pupils complete a revision worksheet in their red homework book. This revision worksheet enables them to recap vocabulary learnt in recent lessons. Pupils are then tested on the same vocabulary on the day the homework is due.	One of the two following options, dependent on what is currently being studied in lessons, or at which point of the course pupils are: a worksheet combining past-paper questions and vocabulary revision, or revision of their speaking exam questions, or occasionally a combination of both.
Geography	Questions in the back of the Geography Unit Booklet. Answers in their red homework book.	Past Exam Paper questions in the homework booklet. Each homework is out of 20 marks.
History	Questions in the back of the History Unit Booklet. Pupils write the answers in their red homework book.	Three different homework tasks on rotation including a previous exam question, revision for a recall test and worksheet on a previous section of a unit.
Computing	Homework activities are mostly practical on a computer which include quizzes we create on Seneca geared specifically to our unit topics.	Flipped learning using course specific videos from Craig'n'Dave's YouTube Channel which involves taking notes ahead of the lesson on the topic. Seneca learning generic assignments and also quizzes we create specifically for our topics. Exam question practice.



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Design Technology	Seneca Tasks to be completed online with a range of reading and questions and magic quizzes.	Homework is set in Seneca with a range of information and questions and AI generated Magic Quizzes which may include watching a video initially. Those unable to access Seneca have revision guide and homework books/ back of exercise books.
Music	Pupils complete two tasks - a revision task based on the relevant core knowledge page and a listen task with five questions to answer. Both tasks are linked to the unit students are studying in class at that time.	Students complete a mixture of the following: exam style questions, past paper exam questions, guided revision tasks and composition development work.
Drama	Pupils use their Core Knowledge Book or online resources to complete tasks/answer questions linked to the current topics in class.	A mixture of past paper questions, logging practical work and research that tests their recall of knowledge or prepares the pupils for future practical content. In Year 11 pupils use homework to learn lines for their scripted performance unit.
